NEED STATEMENT: MEN'S HOPE HOUSING PROGRAM BUILDINGS SIDING & WINDOWS

DESCRIPTION: The Gospel Center Rescue Mission's (GCRM) Men's New Hope Housing Program (NHMP) desperately needs both homes vinyl sided and new windows.

BENEFIT: NHMP is designed to prepare clients to transition out of GCRM successfully through outside employment, GCRM counseling, housing, meal stability, and other GCRM assistance. These two wooden homes are old and their exteriors have been repaired numerous times. Siding & windows will make the buildings more durable, keep animals out, hide unsightly repairs, and drastically improve the aesthetic view of the Campus.

GCRM provides the following programs for those in need living in San Joaquin County:

- Emergency lodging for over 150 men, women and their children each night.
- Representative payee services for over 600 clients.
- Recuperative care services for 20 clients with the completion of the new facility by May 2017.
- Meals for over 300 Clients, Overnight Guests, Program Students & Staff each day - 365 days/year.
- GED preparation, basic math & English, drug addiction programs, job readiness and search, and housing search programs.
- Case management for medical, housing, children, and other social issues.
- Extended programs that can be up to 3 years in addiction recovery, life skills and transition to work leading to life transformation.
- Free Clothing & Furniture Ministry to the homeless & low income.
