DESCRIPTION: New Refrigerated Box Truck: Diesel 5.2L / Refrigeration / Rear Lift

BENEFIT: The Gospel Center Rescue Mission's (GCRM) has developed a model for success for every individual who enters our programs. Within that model is Food Service Program that supplies approximately 600 meals/day to GCRM Program Students, Staff and the homeless community at large. Another key program service is a free clothing, household goods and furniture for the homeless and low income of San Joaquin County. Having a refrigerated box truck will allow for the pick-up of both refrigerated foods such as, but not limited to fruit, vegetables, dairy and meat, as well as other food items, clothing and furniture that does not require refrigeration.
