NEED STATEMENT: UNRESTRICTED & EMERGENCY FUND

DESCRIPTION: The Gospel Center Rescue Mission's (GCRM) Unrestricted & Emergency Fund exists to provide the flexibility to direct funding where it's needed most.

BENEFIT: GCRM provides the following programs for those in need living in San Joaquin County:

- Emergency lodging for over 150 men, women and their children each night.
- Representative payee services for over 560 clients.
- Recuperative care services for 19 clients with the completion of the new facility by May 2017.
- Meals for over 300 clients each day - 365 days/year.
- GED and job readiness and search programs.
- Case management for medical, housing, children, and other social issues.
- Extended programs that can be up to 3 years in addiction recovery, life skills and transition to work leading to life transformation.



COST: \$2,000,000/year requirement. Note all gifts no matter what the size are appreciated. Supporters can make a one-time gift or align this giving to their monthly or annual giving.
