NEED STATEMENT: RECUPERATIVE CARE NEW LIFE PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIPS

DESCRIPTION: The Gospel Center Rescue Mission's (GCRM) provides a 6 month, free, residential recovery and life skills program. Our residents, or “Students,” are people who have lost control of their lives as a result of drugs and/or alcohol which in most cases has resulted in homelessness. **But, there is hope!** The New Life Program is a regeneration program to transition the “Student” from addiction to recovery or homelessness for men and women providing classes, work therapy, and positive activities in the San Joaquin County community. Note that Student’s children are housed as well on Campus. **The New Life Program is an amazing next step for Recuperative Care Program clients.**

BENEFIT: A scholarship will also:

- save a life by help someone overcome addiction to drugs or alcohol,
- give Students a new ”moral compass,”
- feed someone who was hungry and give safe long-term shelter,
- help someone earn a high school diploma (GED) or gain basic literacy,
- help someone transition back to the workforce,
- help someone find permanent housing,
- re-unite a mom or dad with their children or restore a broken marriage, and
- restore someone to be a productive and positive citizen.



COST: \$5,000/Student’s first 6 month program requirement.
