FUNDING OPPORTUNITY: Disaster Refugee & Pandemic Client Relief

DESCRIPTION: Should an earthquake, fire, flood, natural disaster or terrorist event occur in San Joaquin County, the Gospel Center Rescue Mission can accommodate, for several weeks, up to 50 refugees where lodging, food and clothing can be provided. When refugees return to new housing, the Mission can further assist with furniture through its free furniture outreach to the community. This program is in addition to its current overnight Men's Emergency Lodge and New Hope Family Shelter Program for 100 men, women, and children.

BENEFIT: GCRM stands ready to be a leader in homeless solutions for San Joaquin County. This program is just another example of this commitment.

COST: \$50,000/year requirement for 30 days of relief
