## Happy New Year!!!

he Lord has blessed all of us at The Gospel Rescue Mission with family and friends, like you. We have so much to be thankful for. This year 44 New Life Program students were baptized and many of our Mission Kids were dedicated to the Lord. Sixty-four graduates were celebrated at six graduations this year. More than 135,000 meals were served. We saved the physical lives of 18 individuals, due to our First Aid/CPR/AED classes that we teach here at The Mission (if you want a class taught at your church or business, please let us know). We have an amazing team. We have seen addictions overcome, and children reunited with their families! Through the love and grace of our Savior Jesus Christ we witnessed the lives of thousands of individuals and families, touched by His love.

We replaced the sidewalk and curb from our Jesus Saves entrance on Church Street to the corner of San Joaquin Street, and from the corner of San Joaquin and Church all the way to the Bill Brown Building on Sonora. For safety, we installed automatic gates on East Sonora, and cinder block walls on South Hunter and Church streets. These improvements add protection for our students and their children. Our parking lot now has new solar panels, and we added new roof coating on one building. New ADA bathrooms by the entry to the chapel and dining hall were a needed addition. With the help of Stockton Garden Club, we beautified the landscape around our Recuperative Care Centers. This project was even televised on Good Day Sacramento. On the technology side, we installed a new IT system and added new security cameras throughout the campus. A new double door oven was installed in our kitchen. We tore down the two Victorian buildings that slept 19 - making way for the New Life Program Multi-Purpose Center. This new facility will provide 130 much needed beds. As

you read throughout our 'year in review' you will see many other benchmarks and successes. We are thankful.

Our team also goes outside The Mission campus to help and participate with other community organizations, committees, and events. We are honored to assist other Rescue Missions as far as Pennsylvania to start their own Recuperative Care Programs. We love partnering and supporting other organizations to help change many lives throughout our region and nation.

This work could not have been done without your help. We give a huge thank you to all of you - our prayer warriors, partners, donors, friends, and family. Your continued support is invaluable. Because of the Lord and your help, we are glad to say that 71% of our New Life Program students have graduated from the program. Their lives are forever changed. With your generous giving, together, we can change the lives of many unsheltered homeless individuals and families.

As we ring the bell to welcome 2024, please consider partnering with The Mission by making us a consistent part of your giving. We are blessed by gifts of any size. We want you to know that you are loved and appreciated by all of us at The Gospel Center Rescue Mission.
